WASA Covid-19 Guidelines

The following guidelines are in effect for WASA Fall 2020 session. These are recommended by WASA, but the governor's direction, CDC and State and Local health agencies, US Soccer and Westerville Parks and Rec direction will of course supersede this set of recommended actions.

1. **Pre-game self-assessment.** Participants, spectators, referees and coaches should conduct symptom assessments, using CDC guidelines, before arriving at the fields. Anyone experiencing symptoms should stay home.
2. **Wear a mask.** Applies to coaches, referees, spectators and players when not on the field. Players, referees and/or their parents may decide to have players wear masks on the field during play.
3. **All should work toward achieving a 6' social distance** before, during and after games or practices. Of course, active participants won't be able to do this.
4. **No team water coolers or shared drinking stations; avoid snacks.** Athletes and Coaches should use individual water containers marked with names or other individual identification.
5. **No touch** – players should refrain from high fives and other physical contact with teammates, coaches and spectators, including post-game 'Good Game' lineups.
6. **Travel to and from games or practice** Athletes are encouraged to venue with members of their immediate household. Consider limiting the number of spectators.
7. **Coach should keep a list of coaches and players present at each practice and game.** This list shall include the date, beginning and ending time of the practice/game, using the roster that WASA provides. Coach will retain until after the season completes in case some health agency requires this info.
8. **Confirmed COVID case** - If a coach becomes aware of a confirmed COVID case with a player or their immediate family, contact the league at info@wasasoccer.org. The affected party will follow their healthcare provider's direction. WASA will notify the team involved as necessary, respecting the individual's privacy.
